COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM

The first digit of the four numbers in a course number indicates the year in which a student should take that particular course.

- 1 - Freshman year
- 2 - Sophomore year
- 3 - Junior year
- 4 - Senior year

The second digit is a free number which allows for multiple course numbers to be assigned in the same area of study.

The third digit indicates the semester in which the course will normally be offered.

- 0 - no assigned semester
- 1 - Fall semester
- 2 - Spring semester

The fourth digit indicates the number of credit hours awarded for the course.
