Funding:

Students at Messenger College often receive substantial financial aid through the Federal Title IV program that includes Pell Grants and other services. Also, several students have found that their employer will pay most or all the costs of this type education.

The On-Line program also furnishes a year-round access to the studies, with three distinct semesters in which every course may be taken. Each semester is broken into two eight-week terms, thus furnishing six opportunities each year to take any course. The new Pell program now funds summer semesters over and above the regular school year funding. The Messenger College financial aid office can furnish details on these programs.
