

CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) Student Grant Programs

Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF II & HEERF III)

Quarterly Report

September 30, 2021

1. Messenger College signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certificate and Agreement for the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act on April 24, 2020. This document is assurance that MC has used, or intends to use, the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
2. As of June 30, 2021, the total amount of funds MC has been awarded by the Department for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs is \$109,125, including \$20,880 for HEERF II and \$88,245 for HEERF III.
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs as of the date of submissions is \$0.
4. The estimated total number of students at MC that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs was 30 at the time the funds were awarded.
5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs is 0.
6. MC's method to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they will receive under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs will be based on eligibility and qualifying expenses requested in an application.
7. At this time, MC has not provided any instructions, directions, or guidance to students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants from the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs. The institution has decided not to award the additional grants to students, as students have been awarded funds from previous grants and student need could not be established.
