Articulation Agreement

This agreement is made between Messenger College and Mission One Eleven to solidify a commitment to excellence and value in ministry preparation.

1. Under Messenger College’s current degree completion, Mission One Eleven students, if they take any course listed below and pass with a “C,” may transfer the following credits **after successfully completing (i.e. with at least a “C”) one course at MC:**

Missiology of Unreached People Groups	SOC2023 Marriage & Family as Social Science General Education course
Spiritual Formation in Missional Context	DIS1023 Spiritual Formation
Acts	NTB3113 Acts
Methods of Orality	Humanities Elective OR Ministry Emphasis Elective
Current Issues in Missional Studies	Ministry Emphasis Elective
Mission One Eleven Practicum (a 6-week contextual experience working with an unreached people group)	Internship course plus 2 other Ministry Emphasis Elective Course

*This list may be modified at the discretion of MC, after written notification to Mission One Eleven, to include or exclude other specific courses if the curriculum changes.

2. Students must enroll as degree-seeking students.
3. Mission One Eleven must inform MC’s Academic Office of any changes to the current curriculum made subsequent to the date of this agreement.
4. Any course transfers will be reviewed and evaluated by the Academic Office based on MC’s current course requirements and credit transfer policy. Only courses with an earned grade of “C” or better will transfer. Each applicant will be reviewed and accepted based on MC’s current admission policy.

5. In exchange, Mission One Eleven agrees to promote Messenger College programs to its students as applicable (i.e. to either specific students and/or in a promotional/recruitment context).

Students are advised that MC courses are 8 or 16 weeks. Financial aid is available for most students enrolled in MC courses; however, each student should contact the Financial Aid Director individually to ensure their eligibility.

This articulation agreement will remain in effect unless either party gives thirty days written notice of intent to dissolve the agreement.

All students may access any information about this agreement and/or federal regulations in accordance with Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools' (TRACS) standards on MC's website and in MC's publications, including the current Academic Catalog.
